PASTOR'S COLUMN

We have a big announcement to make. **On September 11th of this year, we will be going back to three Sunday services.** The times will be as follows: 8:00 a.m. Traditional, 9:15 a.m. Contemporary and 10:35 a.m. Contemporary. Saturday evening will remain at 5:00 p.m.

Why are we going to go back to three services? It has mostly to do with our children. We believe that the education of our young people is a matter of utmost importance. The key teachers are the parents and the greatest lessons are learned in the Christian home. The church is here to help the parents in this process of Christian education and training. When we changed and dropped the late service and offered a children's church option during the 9:10 service, many took this as Sunday School. It was not meant to replace Sunday School but to simply offer a 20 minute children's worship service. The main teaching time was to be during the education hour of 10:30. Instead of that happening, many children were taken home after church and no longer came to The Source. This was an unforeseen and upsetting result of dropping a service.

As a church council and staff, we prayed over this matter and felt that the spiritual teaching of our children was too important not to act. We felt that the best option was to add the service back. This will also give the adults who help in The Source an opportunity to worship.

Our hope and prayer is that this move will be a blessing to many people. We hope that it will allow more people an opportunity to worship and more children to attend The Source. We also pray that more families will make time to worship with their children and attend an adult class during their time at church on Sundays.

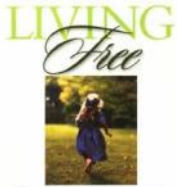
CELEBRATION AND THANKSGIVING CORNER

PRAYING FOR THE MUSLIM WORLD

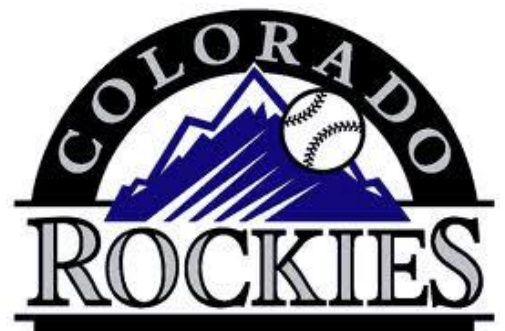
