LUTHERAN FAMILY SERVICES

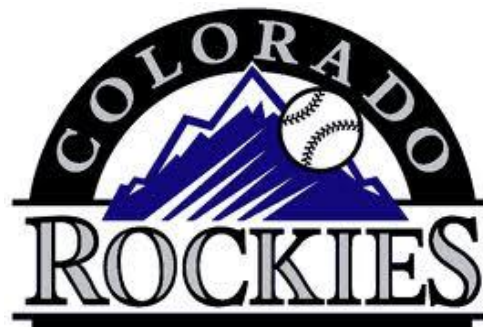
